They love to explore the parks in the area, travel and do everything in between; from horseback riding to soccer practice. Amy was born with a moderate-severe hearing loss, bilaterally and used an FM system growing up. She has been a TDHH for the past 20 years and has been a hoh/Deaf role model with Hands and Voices for the past 3 years. She is passionate about advocacy and education, as she has friends who are hearing, hard of hearing and Deaf; She is always learning.
