Special educators are often called upon to help families be aware of and navigate services and supports for their child across environments. If you are new to working with students with ASD, you likely need to learn this information yourself.

Here in MN, we have a Minnesota Autism Resource Portal that provides guidance to families and service providers. In the portal, the Pathway to Services and Support for ASD document is a great place to start understanding the services available as well as differences in educational eligibility versus medical diagnosis.
