## **Workshop description:**

CueOn gives cuers unique opportunities to interact with Deaf Cueducators through authentic learning conversations. Using video conferencing, learners will be able to practice their receptive and expressive cueing skills. CueOn gives cue learners targeted practice time to build proficiency and the confidence needed to engage Deaf cuers.

## **Presenter:**

Dr. Daniel Koo is the Director of School of Human Services and Sciences and Professor of Psychology at Gallaudet University. He earned a Bachelor's degree from University of Maryland, College Park, a Masters' degree in ASL Linguistics from Gallaudet University, and a Ph.D in Brain and Cognitive Science from the University of Rochester. Deaf since birth, he began cueing when he was 9 and signing when he was 11. Now father to twin boys, Aspen and Logan, and husband to Sherry, he is actively involved in the deaf community, his local church, and the boys' sports activities. In addition, Dr. Koo is one of the co-founders of CueOn, a tutoring company for cuers, and volunteers his time as the Treasurer of CueSign Inc.
