The LINKS[®] Curriculum capitalizes on students' strengths, interests and abilities. It emphasizes the concept of self-determination and positive transitions from school to post-school settings.

The curriculum connects assessment and instruction to provide the instructors the tools to assess, teach and monitor student progress within daily functional routines. The workshop will focus on the assessment of a students skills during naturally occurring routines, the selection of appropriate learning goals, as well as instruction utilizing evidenced-based strategies, including Discrete Trial Training (DT).
