Registered Unlicensed Electricians

The state requires that people doing electrical work of any kind must be licensed. Anyone can apply and be registered as an “unlicensed electrician.” However, there are limitations in the scope of work one can perform. Schools often use an “unlicensed” person to do repair work only.

A registered unlicensed electrician is limited to performing specific electrical work they must complete two hours of continuing education on the electrical code annually. To learn more, go to: [MN Department of Labor’s website](#).
