**Math Masters** is a mathematics competition with a 30+ year history in Minnesota. The goal of the program is to challenge 4th, 5th, and 6th-grade students to use critical thinking and problem-solving skills in mathematics. Students compete as individuals and on teams in multiple rounds of questions during a half-day event in March or April (registered schools select a date and competition location). Students' academic effort and achievement are recognized with plaques, medals, and ribbons in each competition element: Fact Drill, Individual Round, and Team Competition. At the end of the Math Masters season, the top finishers throughout the state are invited to celebrate at a Minnesota Twins game.

SparkPath partners with Math Masters, also a Minnesota non-profit organization, to host a competition for 5th graders at our office building in Arden Hills.
